Subject: EDN Registration - Further Trial Fumigations

Trust you've been well since we met at the first EDN Hearing in Wellington last year.

I wanted to reach out to you about this matter, as we recently received the Directions and Minutes from the DMC regarding EDN - made available on your website.

We understand from this, that Draslovka and WorkSafe will be responding by the end of this week, on the additional field work that is referred to.

Presumably this would involve EDN fumigations of log stacks, the taking of field measurements and reporting of the results.

We have two comments in relation to this, which we wanted to share:

1. Making sure a capable independent assessment organisation is involved in the data collection and reporting process
2. Including the demonstration of EDN recapture equipment, on at least some of the log stacks being fumigated

As there were concerns expressed surrounding the efficiency and other aspects of EDN recapture, undertaking this would be beneficial in evaluating recapture as one of the controls under consideration.

Thanks very much for taking this on board, we would be very interested to talk further about this and our involvement.

Have copied in our GM Technical Joe Falco, who will be taking over my role in April here at Nordiko.
