Good morning

T&G Global supports the application for a waiver to the requirement to apply recapture technology for methyl bromide fumigations to 28th October 2021. The current implementation date of 28th April 2020 for recapture is approximately 60% through our Japan programme due to harvest timing of the different varieties and has led to significant uncertainty with our customers in Japan whom we are currently developing our 2021 selling plans with. The date of 28th October will allow T&G Global to complete all fumigations and fulfil orders for the season for the coming season with confidence we can deliver.

We will also continue our development work around recapture of methyl bromide and continue our push for a systems approach which would remove the fumigation step in the future.
