

Errata Sheet for GMR07001 Evaluation and Review Report As at 24 September 2008

1. Page 30, Section 8.3.4

Submitters expressed concern about the first commercial release of a genetically modified organism:

“As the first commercial release of a GM organism [in] this country this application requires a comprehensive evaluation” (Bryant, Carapiet, Thomas).

“As a first conditional release the distribution of benefits and risks are of concern to the whole of the New Zealand public who share in our overall National identity, values and wellbeing” (Bryant, Carapiet, Thomas).

2. Page 54, Section 8.19.10

The applicant submitted that *“There will be a glut of horses which will need disposal at significant costs, especially in areas where burial of carcasses is seen as a ground water risk”* (page 79 of application)

3. Page 46, Section 8.16.21

And in relation to the claimed benefit of reduction of glut of dead horses which would need disposal. As previously discussed, the horse mortality rate from Equine Influenza is between 1-8% (Naylor, 2004).
