I act for Fisheries Inshore NZ, New Zealand Federation of Commercial Fishermen, Talley's Group Limited, The Southern Inshore Fisheries Management Co Limited, Macdonald & Brown Limited and Cloudy Bay Clams Limited (**Fisheries Submitters**)

The Fisheries Submitters wish to acknowledge they have not filed the memorandum signalled in counsel's email dated 5 December 2016. This is because the Fisheries Submitters have sought to lead discussions between the Environment Court parties this week in a bid to see whether an agreed timetable might be placed before the DMC for consideration. The Fisheries Submitters consider agreement would avoid the:

- necessity for further argument on hearing preparation procedure; and
- prospect of new legal proceedings on procedural points of law; or
- appeals and judicial review of procedural points of law following the release of the DMC's decision in these proceedings.

The Fisheries Submitters reserve the right to file a memorandum addressing their views on the lawfulness and reasonableness of the present timetable, but consider that there is merit in seeing whether agreement can be reached before Monday 12 December as this would likely facilitate a more efficient hearing process.

I would, once again, be grateful if this email was placed before the DMC at your earliest convenience.
