Thank you for providing copies of the DMC's timetable directions.

The purpose of this email is to place the EPA and DMC on notice that counsel for the Fisheries Submitters (including Talley's Group Limited), Te Runanga o Ngati Ruanui Trust and Kiwis Against Seabed Mining Incorporated are preparing a memorandum in response to the DMC's timetable directions, which they consider to be (amongst other things) unreasonable and unlawful.
