Thanks for your email.

Our experts were expecting to take part in caucusing which was cancelled in Minute 43 on 9 May. They have since started to prepare written evidence which they were not expecting to have to do prior to the cancellation of caucusing.

This has given the experts five days to prepare written evidence. Liz Slooten has been at the International Whaling Commission (IWC) over the last two weeks and Shaw Mead returned on 12 May from another work assignment prepared to take part in caucusing sometime after 12 May but was unable to attend to anything before this.

John Cockrem would also like to file further evidence and has not had the time with other commitments to prepare evidence by 2pm but expects to have draft evidence by 5pm on Friday.
