During the TTRL application hearing, the Decision-making Committee (DMC) expressed their wish to understand more about the locations of areas which have been identified by submitters as being of significance to recreational interests (such as fishing and diving), particularly the subtidal reefs. As your presentation to the hearing referred to such areas, we are following up on the invitation extended by the DMC at the hearing to provide written details of such locations in the coastal area of the South Taranaki Bight, if you have not already done so. In particular, where photographs have been taken and provided as evidence, the DMC asks that submitters provide details of the locations at which these were taken.
