Hearing Notice – 29 October 2018

Notice of Hearing Dates and Venue

1. The EPA gives notice under clause 1 of Schedule 3 of the Act that it will conduct a hearing on the Coastal Resources Limited (CRL) marine dumping consent application.
2. The hearing is scheduled to commence on **Wednesday 28 November 2018** at **9.30am** in the Kiwi Ballroom on the ground floor, Jet Park Airport Hotel and Conference Centre, 63 Westney Road, Mangere, Auckland. From Monday 3 December 2018, the hearing will continue in another location in Central Auckland until it is completed or as further advised by the Decision-making Committee (DMC).
3. The hearing may begin with a mihi whakatau and an opening statement from the Chair.
