The Tuna run from Hokio Beach migrates past the Taranaki basin, and when they have spawned, the glass eels travel back the other way. These runs include the Log Fin Eel, which is becoming rare. The pollution and actions may harm this two way annual event. My personal observations from fishing the glass eels for 5 years on the coast have been a decline in numbers caught. The current catch numbers will not sustain an eel fishery. Every barrier to their path must be removed.
