1. The Tamarind development drilling applications were open for submission for 30 working days from 4 May 2018 to 18 June 2018.

2. The EPA received 124 submissions.

4. 104 do not wish to speak to their submission.

5. Climate Justice Taranaki Incorporated (CJT) created an online submissions form for its members and other members of the public to submit through. We received 95 submissions through CJT's form.
6. Submitters that used CJT's form were able to tick pre-set statements that the submitter agreed with and submitters were also provided a free text field to add any additional comments.
