## Submissions period

1. The OMV marine discharge application was open for submission for 30 working days from 28 May 2018 to 9 July 2018.

## Submitter statistics

### *Total number of submissions received*

2. 44 submissions

### *Submitters wishing to be heard*

3. Eight submitters wish to speak to their submission at the hearing. Four are representing organisations
  - a) Greenpeace New Zealand Incorporated,
  - b) Climate Justice Taranaki Incorporated,
  - c) Frack Free Kapiti and Beyond,
  - d) Te Runanga o Ngati Ruanui, and
  - e) Te Kotahitanga o Te Atiawa Trust and Nga Hapu o Te Atiawa.

Two submitters wish to present in Te Reo Māori. Since submitting their submission Greenpeace New Zealand have stated in an email that they do not want to speak at the hearing and will therefore not be providing an expert witness at the hearing.

### *Form submissions*

4. Climate Justice Taranaki Incorporated (CJT) created an online submissions form for its members and other members of the public to use. There were 34 submissions using CJT's form.
5. Submitters that used CJT's form were able to tick pre-set statements that the submitter agreed with, and submitters were also provided a free text field to add any additional comments.

### Substantive submissions

6. Eight submissions had attachments with substantive discussion, including suggested conditions.

### Submitter experts

7. Greenpeace New Zealand was the only submitter intending to have an expert witness support its submission at the hearing. However this position has changed, and now Greenpeace New Zealand will not be presenting at the hearing.

### Common themes

8. To refuse or defer the decision made on the OMV application and, instead, jointly process this notified application with the planned non-notified application signalled by OMV to be lodged at the end of July. The CJT submissions form had this point as standard text.
9. The cumulative impacts of all OMV activity (two of the substantive submissions.)
10. Climate change (three substantive submissions), as well as in the standardized text of the CJT submission form.
11. The discharged volumes of hazardous substances, the rainfall calculations, and the ecotoxicity of the substances.
