Notification of Environmental Protection Authority's decision on the application by OMV New Zealand Limited for marine discharge consent (EEZ100017)

Summary of decision

On 4 October 2017, a Decision-making Committee (DMC) appointed by the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) granted a marine discharge consent to OMV New Zealand Limited. The consent is for the discharge of trace amounts of harmful substances from hazardous and non-hazardous deck drains from one or more Mobile Offshore Drilling Units operating in six permit areas offshore Taranaki.
