
OMV New Zealand deck drainage application

Application for a marine discharge consent to discharge harmful substances from deck drains (EEZ100017)

On 27 March 2018 OMV New Zealand Limited (OMV) lodged an application with the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) for a marine discharge consent. The consent is for the discharge of trace amounts of harmful substances from hazardous and non-hazardous deck drains from one or more Mobile Offshore Drilling Units. In accordance with section 46 of the Exclusive Economic Zone and Continental Shelf (Environmental Effects) Act 2012 (the EEZ Act), the EPA gives notice of this application.

Summary of the application

OMV has lodged an application for a marine discharge consent to discharge trace amounts of harmful substances from the deck drains of mobile offshore drilling units as offshore processing drainage. The 12 proposed wells, where the discharges from the mobile offshore drilling unit may occur, are located offshore Taranaki over six permit areas as shown on the map below. The duration of consent sought is to the end of 2025.



A full description of the proposal is included in the Impact Assessment that accompanies the application, which is available at the locations specified below.
