

### Change of operation from a face-to-face hearing to a remote hearing

1. Further to the hearing notice ([Hearing Notice Link](#)) issued on Monday 10 August 2020 and the hearing procedures ([Hearing Procedures Link](#)) issued on Friday 24 July 2020, the DMC advises that, following the announcement of COVID-19 Alert Levels on Monday 24 August (Auckland moving from level 3 to level 2 from midnight on the 30 August and the rest of the country remaining at level 2), the hearing for the Beach Energy application will no longer be held as a face-to-face hearing in Dunedin and will now be conducted by means of video conference as a fully remote hearing on Tuesday 8 September 2020.
2. Parties to the hearing, such as the applicant and submitters presenting, will be sent invitations with the details as to how to join the Hearing's Zoom Webinar as a participant. The invites, and further details, will be sent out closer to the time of the hearing.
3. As a public process, any member of the public can also join and watch the Zoom Webinar. The voices of non-submitter members of the public will, however, be muted and will be unable to ask questions or provide any comments. The public links for each day will be provided on the website for public access.
