## Notification of the Environmental Protection Authority's decision on an application by Beach Energy Resources NZ (Holdings) Limited for marine discharge consent (EEZ100019)

### Summary of decision

On 27 October 2020, a Decision-making Committee under delegated authority from the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) **GRANTED**, subject to conditions, an application submitted by Beach Energy Resources NZ (Holdings) Limited for marine discharge consent. This consent authorises the discharge of trace amounts of harmful substances from the deck drains (offshore processing drainage) of a Mobile Offshore Drilling Unit (MODU) within Petroleum Exploration Permit (PEP) area 38264, located in the Canterbury Basin. The consent expires 7 November 2029.
