Hi Scott

The structure extends over the whole site as shown on the photograph. The only things that are going are the turbines which are in fact aircraft engines and are just a plant components within the structure. To be clear, MRP was interested to see a design option that avoided the site completely, or at a minimum just clipped the south end. If the alignment is further north, then I cannot see how you can leave us with the same amount of land as HJ Drive will need to extend further south to meet the highway.

In terms of the options presented, we are very disappointed that Options 2 and 3 were even contemplated after our discussions, but take this to be a misunderstanding around the assets that are being retained. Option 4 looks to be the best of the lot provided there was an opportunity to be kept whole on the total area of developable land, but it will certainly warrant more detailed analysis from our engineers. The adjacency of the existing vacant section is much preferable.

Will await your alternative southern alignment.
