

## **HEARING SUMMARY – LIAM WINTER – PLANNING**

### **Scope**

1. I have been involved in the East West Link project since October 2016 as part of the team which provides Auckland Transport's third party input on major planning applications. In this capacity, I give planning evidence focusing on the designation conditions of particular interest to Auckland Transport.

### **Clarifications and Updates**

2. My rebuttal evidence refers to a number of conditions which have been agreed with Ms Lesley Hopkins. In a number of instances, the numbering used in my statement differs from that used by Ms Hopkins in her most recent iteration of the conditions (19 July). For the avoidance of doubt:
  - DC.11(l) in my statement corresponds to Ms Hopkins' DC.11(k);
  - DC.11(o) in my statement corresponds to Ms Hopkins' DC.12(a);
  - CT.10 in my statement corresponds to Ms Hopkins' CT.9; and
  - NU.6 in my statement corresponds to Ms Hopkins' NU.10.
3. My rebuttal evidence refers to a Consenting Phase Agreement between Auckland Transport and the Transport Agency. The Agreement addresses several discrete Auckland Transport issues, and is intended as a supplement to the conditions. I am advised that sign-off on this document from Auckland Transport's Chief Infrastructure Officer is imminent.

### **Overview**

4. In my opinion, the designation conditions I have agreed with Ms Hopkins, in conjunction with the Consenting Phase Agreement, appropriately address the matters raised by Auckland Transport in its submission.
