ERRATUM: RECOMMENDATION REPORT

DATE: 20 MARCH 2020

1. There are small errors in the recommendation report that contradict the recommended Water Conservation Order.
 - a) Paragraph 242 of the recommendation report (under the Dissolved Oxygen heading) should say that '*the Special Tribunal's conclusion is that water discharging from the Springs should have a saturated value of no less than 45%*' (rather than 50% as stated in the recommendation report issued on 17 March 2020). The limit specified in Schedule 3 of the recommended Water Conservation Order says 45%, and this is correct.
 - b) In paragraph 242 after "Considering the above evidence ..." there should have been a footnote referring to "In particular, the evidence of Roger Young at paragraph 147 on page 40."
2. All members of the Special Tribunal concur that these errors were transpositional and the correct determination is as above.
3. The recommendation report that appears on the EPA website has been amended accordingly.
