There should be no further allocation of water for irrigation within the catchment areas of the Springs as any increase in irrigation would decrease the flow to the Springs and the resultant increase in stocking rates would cause a degradation of water quality. Consents should not be issued for any other water takes from the Springs catchment e.g for bottling or gold mining. Because of the potential for contamination of the aquifer from settling ponds associated with alluvial mining or heavy metals associated with hard rock mining, no consents for mining should be issued in the Springs catchment.
