I also acknowledge that all aquifer and surrounding rivers and springs are a deep and unknown system yet to be fully understood. In line with viewing what is left of our ecosystems as our sustainer rather than a endless resource to be plundered (Maori vs. Pakeha way) there is great wisdom in stopping any intensification of extraction here and now. There appear to be very few truly healthy rivers and aquifers left in New Zealand.
