Please tell them below what's important to you::	It is vital that the conservation order is put in place to ensure that further protecting the te waikoropupu springs is ensured. I have had a long association with the springs in the early 70s I use to accompany my father to take water samples every Sunday to allow scientists to evaluate the source and age of the water. My mother who was a board member of the Abel Tasman national park in the late 80s was instrumental in dealing with the macullums who owned the land surrounding the springs to shift ownership to the crown and management to the dept of lands and survey. We can look back at the history of protecting the springs and be proud of past efforts. However this is the next step in protecting one of nature’s treasures.
