The proposed plan, will effectively lock in policies and expectations. This will make large areas of hill and high country land unviable to farm, because of fencing requirements, fresh water and Nitrogen leaching and slope usage restrictions. All these requirements add more cost to the business resulting, less stock being farm and essentially decreasing the farm's production/viability and in a broader sense the nation's economy.

Shep should be exempt from waterway restrictions because they naturally do not congregate in waterways, unlike dairy cattle and dairy beef finishing.

Intensive grazing of crops should be allowed to have buffer zones (catchment area), including gullies as the last break, (3 to 7 days only) to enable these areas less noxious weed growth and establishment.

Even though we have reticulated water schemes already (a proposed requirement in this Policy), we are having to now use smaller breaks, which means the use of more temporary water troughs and tanks on trailers because it is not permissible to graze to the gullies.

We tend not to use sacrifice paddocks because in the past have found it results in brassica diseases spreading and affecting next year's crops. The temporary fencing onto the tops of ridges and grazing from the top to bottom is at the point of creating an animal welfare issue because there is less shelter.
