Official Information Act Request

Dear ██████████

I refer to your request received on 6 August 2020, for the following information:

"... I would like to find out how the Ngā Kaihautū Tikanga rōpū gets paid. For example, is it an Honorarium, salary, hourly rate etc as well as how much they get paid."

Your request has been treated as a request for information under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA).

Ngā Kaihautū Tikanga Taiao members are paid a daily fee in accordance with the Cabinet Fees Framework for a Group 4, Level 2 body. The daily fee ranges from \$390 - \$885 for the chair and \$290 - \$560 for members. The chair and members submit monthly claims for fees based on time worked, to a maximum of 8 hours per day, with the option of a pro-rata hourly rate if needed.

The current fees for Ngā Kaihautū Tikanga Taiao are as follows:

- Tumuaki \$90 per hour or \$720 per day max
- Kaihautū \$58.75 per hour or \$470 per day max.

You have the right to seek an investigation and review of this decision by the Ombudsman. You can contact the Ombudsman on 0800 802 602, or by email at info@ombudsman.parliament.nz.
