Request for information from Waka Kotahi in relation to the resource consent applications and notices of requirement for Stage 1B1 of the Papakura to Drury South State Highway 1 improvements (FTC000015) under the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020

The Papakura to Drury South State Highway 1 improvements Expert Consenting Panel (the Panel) has directed the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) to request further information from you under clause 25 of Schedule 6 of the COVID-19 Recovery Act 2020 (the Act), relating to the applications and notices of requirement.

At the direction of the Panel, the EPA is seeking the following information and clarification:

1. A copy of the Ngaati Whanaunga Strategic Management Plan 2019 referred to at paragraph 8.5.6 and note 60 of the AEE;
2. Clarification of the location of the northern extent of the third lanes (north and south bound) on SH1. The AEE at 2.1.1 refers to the third lane northbound and southbound "from south of Bremner Road (Ch. 13,660)..", where that chainage appears to be north of Bremner Road;
3. The revised plans at Appendix F do not show the location of the proposed designation on Sheets 9 and 15. Please check and provide any necessary corrected plans.

In accordance with clause 25 of Schedule 6 of the Act the applicants and requiring authority must

- a) Provide electronic copies of the information or report requested; or
- b) Advise the EPA, with reasons that you decline to provide the information or report requested.


Please provide the further information to the EPA by Thursday 16 September 2021.
