**Request for information from Waka Kotahi in relation to the resource consent applications and notices of requirement for Stage 1B1 of the Papakura to Drury South State Highway 1 improvements (FTC000015) under the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020**

The Papakura to Drury South State Highway 1 improvements Expert Consenting Panel (the Panel) has directed the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) to request further information from you under clause 25 of Schedule 6 of the COVID-19 Recovery Act 2020 (the Act), relating to the applications and notices of requirement.

At the direction of the Panel, the EPA is seeking the following information and clarification:

1. The three iwi CVA/CIA's contained in Appendix E refers to the Southern Structure Plans (SSP) joint Cultural Values Assessment (CVA). References to the SSP CVA are also included in other parts of the application.

Please confirm if this is a CVA covering the entire Papakura to Drury South State Highway 1 improvements listed project.

2. .Three iwi have agreed to provide addendums to the SSP CVA as part of their CVA's/CIA's for Stage 1B1.

Please provide the SSP CVA.

In accordance with clause 25 of Schedule 6 of the Act the applicants and requiring authority must

- a) Provide electronic copies of the information or report requested; or
- b) Advise the EPA, with reasons that you decline to provide the information or report requested.


Please provide the further information to the EPA by Thursday 16 September 2021.

If the information requested is not received, the panel must proceed as if the request for further information has been declined.

Please note, the information will be provided to the panel, the application and every person who provided comments on the application/notice of requirement. The information will also be made available on the EPA website.
