Request for information from Queenstown Lakes District Council under the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020

The Queenstown Arterials Project Expert Consenting Panel (the panel), has directed the EPA to request further information from you under clause 25 of Schedule 6 of the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020 (the Act), relating to Queenstown Arterials Project resource consent application and notice of requirement.

The panel has been unable to determine or find the duration of consents being requested by Queenstown Lakes District Council for the consents you are applying for. As such, on behalf of the panel, the EPA is seeking the following information:
