Permit to import

A permit to import the goods listed below is issued under clause 5 of the Imports and Exports (Asbestos-containing Products) Prohibition Order 2016.

- A Sisson and Company Limited 1941 Steam Engine; and
- An equivalent make and model in regards to the design, position, and volume of asbestos lagging within the steam engine (yet to be sourced).

Conditions

1. The goods listed above must not contain asbestos exceeding a weight of 10 kg in total.
2. The goods listed above are permitted for the purpose of restoring a 1910 passenger ferry, SS THE MINERVA, to its original condition.
3. When an equivalent make and model steam engine has been sourced, the permit holder must notify the Environmental Protection Authority of the make and model and estimated volume of asbestos prior to importation.
4. As far as practicable, the asbestos lagging must remain enclosed between the metal cladding and the cylinders so that the asbestos is adequately contained at all times.
5. Notwithstanding Condition 4, if it becomes necessary to remove the metal cladding or the asbestos lagging is otherwise exposed, the asbestos lagging shall be removed and replaced with an asbestos-free alternative. If the metal cladding is removed, this must be done under the direct supervision of a licensed handler of asbestos, and all persons must comply with the Health and Safety at Work (Asbestos) Regulations 2016.
6. Any disposal of asbestos lagging or contaminated material must be at an approved asbestos disposal site.

Note: The Health and Safety at Work (Asbestos) Regulations 2016 impose requirements regarding work involving asbestos (including transporting, storing, removing, using, handling, disposing or disturbing asbestos) which you will need to comply with.
