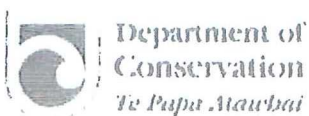

Powerlines

The application of the Pesticide will comply with the requisite provisions of the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996 and Hazardous Substances Regulations. The Department will follow all safety precautions required by the Health Protection Officer at the Waikato District Health Board, and is confident that the risks posed by the Pesticide to people, wildlife and stock are negligible. However, as dogs are extremely vulnerable to poisoning they should be kept tied up or made to wear muzzles for at least three months after the application of the Pesticide.

The Department agrees to the following:

1. To undertake best endeavours to remove any pesticide that falls outside the operational area.
2. To reimburse the owner of any stock shown to have been killed by ingestion of the pesticide **outside** the operational area only where the death is a direct cause of the negligent acts of the Department. \*
3. To give a minimum of 24 hours warning of Pesticide application to allow the landowner and/or occupier to move stock.
4. To provide muzzles for dogs belonging to the landowner and/or occupier if requested.
5. To provide reports and results of the pesticide operation to the landowner and/or occupier if requested.
6. To provide other information relating to the pesticide operation where it is requested, provided that the requested information is readily available.

\* Please notify the nearest Department Office within 12 hours of the death of any stock which you suspect was caused by ingestion of the Pesticide. The Department will arrange for a veterinarian from the Ministry for Primary Industries to take tissue samples for analysis.
