Notification of the Environmental Protection Authority's decision on an application by DW New Zealand Limited for its non-notified marine dumping consent (EEZ400012)

Summary of decision

On 30 April 2020, the Environmental Protection Authority **GRANTED**, subject to conditions, an application by DW New Zealand Limited for a non-notified marine dumping consent. The decision authorises consent to dump the fishing vessel named 'Dong Won 701' within one of the five 'authorised locations' listed in the Exclusive Economic Zone and Continental Shelf (Environmental Effects – Discharge and Dumping) Regulations 2015, located 25 nautical miles south-east of Otago Harbour. This marine dumping consent will expire on 31 December 2021.
