## Notification of the Environmental Protection Authority's decision on the review of condition 8 and 17 of DWNZ Limited's marine dumping consent (EEZ400012)

### Summary of decision

On 21 May 2021, the General Manager CLO under delegated authority from the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) decided to change conditions 8 and 17 of DW New Zealand (DWNZ) Limited's marine dumping consent, following a review of those consent conditions. The marine dumping consent authorises the dumping of the fishing vessel named 'Dong Won 701' within one of the five 'authorised locations' listed in the Exclusive Economic Zone and Continental Shelf (Environmental Effects – Discharge and Dumping) Regulations 2015, located 25 nautical miles south-east of Otago Harbour. This marine dumping consent will expire on 31 December 2021.
