Pursuant to s 162(2) of the Exclusive Economic Zone and Continental Shelf (Environmental Effects) Act 2012, the EPA provides ruling EEZ500027 to Beach Energy Resources NZ (Kupe) Limited for the following activities:

The placement of structures on the seabed under ss 20(2)(a), 20(2)(e), 20(2)(f), 20(2)(g), and 20(4)(a) of the EEZ Act:

The placement and removal of the subsea assembly, where:

- 1
- a) The placement and removal of the subsea assembly will be performed using certified equipment.
 - b) The placement and removal of the subsea assembly will be performed by suitably qualified and experienced personnel.
 - c) The placement and removal of the subsea assembly will be installed around the KS-2 well conductor.
 - d) The removal is performed no later than 36 months after installation.

The placement of structures on the seabed under ss 20(2)(a), 20(2)(e), 20(2)(f), 20(2)(g), and 20(4)(a) of the EEZ Act

The placement and removal of the databuoy, mooring lines, umbilical and anchors, where:

- a) No more than four (4) anchors are placed on the seabed, and each has a footprint of no more than (4) square metres.
 - b) The anchor systems are placed and removed only once.
 - c) The removal is performed no later than 36 months after installation.
